Medical Care System

Our department has four full-time pediatricians (three specialists).

Full-time and day-shift doctors share the responsibility for both outpatient and inpatient care.

Out patient services are available without an appointment in the mornings. Afternoon services require an appointment.

We will determine the need for hospitalization as quickly as possible, but will discuss treatment plans with the patient and guardian.

We conduct oral food challenges (inpatient/out patient) and endocrine disease evaluations (inpatient).

Inpatient Treatment

Room Guidance

Inpatient care is provided by the on-call pediatrician at night, ensuring treatments are administered safely.

We will assign you to a private room, two-bed, or four-bed room depending on availability and your medical condition. Additional charges may apply for private rooms.

Care of hospitalized children

Preschool children must be accompanied by a family member at all times during their hospital stay.

The private room fee will be waived if the child needs breastfeeding and the mother is present full-time.

Visitation and accompanying policies may vary based on bed availability and current infection control measures.

Medical Examination

Reception hours: Monday - Friday AM8:30 - 11:30 2nd and 4th Saturday AM8:30 - 11:00

Outpatients Services: While walk-in patients are accepted, priority is given to those with referrals or severe conditions requiring hospitalization.

Patients with referrals may schedule an appointment for 2 or more days after calling by phone.

Specialized outpatient service:

• Endocrinology and Neurology After consultation or examination at general outpatient services (available without appointment), an appointment will be scheduled.

• Allergy and Cardiology Patients with referrals can schedule appointments by phone.

Immunization and Health Checkup: Appointments can be scheduled by phone or in person at the reception.

Emergency referral visit: When a doctor contacts us during consultation hours, our doctors will reply directly.
