Characteristics

Emphasize early intervention for infants and toddlers at high risk for food allergy

- ✓ Has eczema with itching
- \checkmark Has ever had symptoms that suggest a potential food allergy
- ✓ Is avoiding a particular food
- ✓ Has had positive food-specific IgE blood test results

In this case

We will aggressively treat all cases, including mild eczema.

We will gradually introduce small, safe amounts of food, avoiding complete elimination unless necessary.

We prioritize cooperation and smooth transitions with your family doctor

- ✓ What if I suddenly run out of medicine until the next appointment?
- ✓ Do I have to see an allergy specialist regularly?

We recommend visiting your family doctor for prescription if you run out of medication or once your symptoms improve. This helps us continue to accept first-time and more severe patients.

Food allergy

Diagnosis is based on a combination of medical interviews, blood tests, skin tests, and oral food challenges. EpiPen $^{\circledR}$ can be prescribed.

Once eczema and asthma are well controlled and symptom-free, we will begin oral food challenges and gradually reintroduce restricted foods.

Atopic dermatits

Itchy eczema is treated with steroid ointments. Inpatient treatment is available if needed.

Once eczema is under control, maintenance treatment includes intermittent steroid application and topical medications such as Moiselt[®] and Colectim[®]).

Bronchial asthma

We assess asthma severity and initiate or adjust preventive treatments to maintain well-controlled asthma

We explain the condition, aggravating factors, and the importance of long-term management, along with training on proper steroid inhalation techniques,

Allergic rhinitis

Sublingual immunotherapy is available for patients ages 5 and older, upon request.
