Medical Care System

Our department is staffed by three full-time pediatricians and five fixed part-time physicians

- Morning outpatient visits are available without an appointment.
- Afternoon outpatient services are by appointment only.
- We have 10 pediatric beds (infants to school-age children) and 8 neonatal care beds.
- The need for hospitalization is assessed promptly, and treatment plans are decided in consultation with patients and their guardians.
- We actively perform oral food challenges and endocrine function tests during hospitalization.

Inpatient Care

Hospital Stay and Family Support

- Patients are admitted and treated within a safe scope under a nighttime on-call pediatrician system.
- Preschool children are generally required to be accompanied by a family member at night.
- Visiting and caregiver policies may be modified depending on bed availability and infection control situations.

Room Guidance

- Room types (private, two-bed, or four-bed rooms) are assigned according to availability and the patient's condition.
- Additional charges apply for private rooms, but If a mother stays continuously for direct breastfeeding, the private room charge will be waived.

General Outpatient Services

Reception hours: Weekdays: AM8:30 - 11:30 2nd and 4th Saturdays: AM8:30 - 11:00

- Walk-in visits are accepted; however, priority is given to patients with referral letters and those requiring hospitalization.
- Patients with a referral letter may schedule an appointment (from two days later onward) by phone.

Specialized outpatient services:

- Endocrinology / Neurology After initial evaluation (morning general clinic, no appointment required), appointments for specialized clinics will be arranged.
- Allergy / Cardiology : Patients with referral letters may schedule appointments directly by phone.

Immunization & Infant Health Checkups:

Available by appointment only (via phone or at reception).

Emergency referrals:

If a referring physician calls during consultation hours, a pediatrician will respond directly.
